### Play Alloa

Play Alloa aims to create a varied and interesting environment that stimulates social, physical, creative, emotional, and intellectual play for children, young people and adults with disabilities or additional support needs.

Play Alloa provides groups, resources, and activities based on individual interests, abilities, and needs.

- Resources are continually assessed, evaluated, and adapted
- Staff recognise the importance of free play and social experiences with minimal intervention, whilst keeping our participants safe and secure
- We aim to provide a lifelong service which is adaptable and flexible to the needs of our participants and their families

As Play Alloa is a Charity, we rely on grants, fundraising and session fees in order to provide our services. That is why we ask for £6 for each session. Your ongoing support and participation in fundraising to keep services going is greatly appreciated.



#### **Our Activities**

Play Alloa currently runs a pre5 Play Session, age5+ Play Sessions, an ASN After School Group, Youth Clubs, a Lifeskills Group, and a range of Adult Sessions.



We also provide some 1:1 social activity packages in conjunction with Social Services.

# Accessing Our Services

Any parent, carer, or individual can refer a person to Play Alloa. There does not need to be a formal diagnosis.

To access our main service (all services other than the ASN After School Group), you should contact the office by phone or email. You will be given a registration form which must be completed and returned to the office. You will then be invited to come along to an age appropriate session for a 45min visit.

Referrals can also be made by Education, Health or Social services with the families permission. Once a referral form has been received, we will make contact with the family or individual involved.



While most of these run during school term only, we also deliver a number of School Holiday Play, and Youth, sessions as well as other activities (funding dependant).





Play Alloa is Care Inspectorate Registered for Daycare of Children. All Staff and Volunteers have a clear PVG (Protection of Vulnerable Groups) Record.

Staff and Volunteers are all provided with training, induction and regular CPD.
